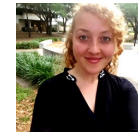

found to be minimally invasive. Because robotics minimizes invasiveness, there is less blood loss, less scarring, fewer complications, and a shorter recovery period. Robyn's dissertation address the economics of robotic surgery. She earned her doctorate's degree from the University of South Florida. Robyn joined Tampa AAUW this year.
