Moving Forward

Tampa AAUW has just completed a successful fiscal year during which the Affiliate's membership increased by more than 25%,thanks to the leadership of Director of Membership Shella Miller, and the work of many Membership Ambassadors. Additionally, over \$4,000.00 was made at the annual fundraiser. Therefore, Tampa was able to pay a full week of expenses (\$1100 each) for two Tech/Trek campers ,as well as award \$1,000 scholarships to two upper-class University of South Florida students.

However, the Affiliate's membership structure is evolving. Many new members, in addition to working full time while caring for families, also travel as part of their employment, giving them fewer hours to volunteer. Holding a branch position requires a sincere commitment of talent *and* time. Therefore, after much deliberation, at the June 15th meeting, the Board of Directors voted to create a free-standing vice president position. A member holding the Vice President position will share the president's responsibilities, while maintaining a full vote.

This year will be a transitional year because the President and the Director of Tech Trek/STEM Activities will leave the Board June 30, 2020. A vacancy already exists for Director of Communications. Therefore, having someone step into the Vice President position at the beginning of the 2019-2020 fiscal year will give the Affiliate the flexibility and support needed to continue on a successful path.

After approval by state AAUW, the amendment for the Vice President position will be passed to Tampa AAUW general membership for approval. Look for the proposed amendment in an email very soon. A special election to fill the Vice President's position will be held in October.
