The COVID-19 crisis exposed the many inequities women in our society face. Women of color were especially hard hit — and the consequences of that continue to reverberate. Now, the recovery offers us a unique opportunity not only to tackle the immediate problems, but also to address the underlying issues that led to them. Let's seize the moment to make certain that we recover and rebuild in a way that allows women and their families to thrive.

AAUW has led the fight for fair pay and economic opportunity for women — and the battle continues: Women still get just 83 cents for every dollar paid to a man, and men continue to dominate the top roles and highest-paying professions. Our members, supporters and staff work on local, state and federal levels to support laws and policies that enable women's success. Our work in statehouses and the U.S. Capitol has helped pass hundreds of pieces of legislation. Our Legal Advocacy team has supported plaintiffs in more than 125 gender equity legal cases.

These topics come up at the State and National levels, we also personally need to advocate. The easiest way to stay up to date on the issues is to sign up for The Two Minute Advocate. This service provides you with the information you need to easily voice your opinions and concerns on legislative issues. You can sign up on AAUW National's website or by texting "AAUW" to 21333.

Another way to help is to support the AAUW Action Fund by direct donation. The AAUW Action Fund "advances equity for women and girls through member activism and voter mobilization." There is a link on the AAUW National website to the AAUW Action Fund site.



Tips for Inviting guests to AAUW...

 Know what you are going to say. Have a simple script in mind. You can use 	
something like the following:

2. Be Excited:

People can hear excitement in your voice. The more excited you are about something, the more likely someone would be willing to join you.

3. Make the invitation personal. Invite in person or over the phone. It's more personal than a text or an email. It is so much easier to say no over email or text.

4. Keep it Simple:

Don't overcomplicate the invitation. Ensure you explain, what, where, when, and what time.

5. **Invite and then follow-up:** People forget, so follow-up the week of the meeting, letting the person know how excited you will be to have them as your guest. Let them know they can also invite a friend if they want.
